

Information Public Wireless LAN (PWLAN) WLAN-Service powered by Swisscom

Public Wireless LAN allows people to surf the internet using their notebook or mobile phone in the Messe Basel exhibition halls and at more than 1,200 hotspots in Switzerland. You can have your connections via Public Wireless LAN charged directly to your credit card online, in just a few rapid and simple steps, or you can buy a Value Card in a Swisscom Shop beforehand.

Use with credit card.



Start the browser to call up the entry page.



Select «Credit Card» and specify the credit.



Enter your credit card details.



Save access data (user ID and password) and log in.

Please note the following:

The PWLAN is a service provided by Swisscom (Switzerland) Ltd.. The operation of and support for the PWLAN network is in the hands of Swisscom (Switzerland) Ltd.. Internet access via PWLAN is not a substitute for the conventional cable internet connection provided by MCH Swiss Exhibition (Basel) Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "MCH") but is an additional service.

Wireless data transmission via PWLAN can be impaired or even rendered impossible through sources of interference or the action of third parties, upon which neither Swisscom (Switzerland) Ltd. nor MCH has any influence. The design and materials used for your exhibition stand can thus massively impair PWLAN reception, or even prevent it altogether. The installation of private WLANs, wireless security cameras or other forms of data transfer via radio on either your stand or a neighbouring stand can impair PWLAN reception or prevent it altogether.

Continuous, trouble-free reception cannot therefore be guaranteed. The function of VPN connections, internet telephony or live streams cannot be guaranteed via the PWLAN. MCH and Swisscom (Switzerland) Ltd. do not accept any liability for damages incurred through interruptions or malfunctions of the PWLAN.

Please therefore clarify in advance whether the limitations set out above are acceptable for your intended purpose. In case of doubt, you should make use of our offer of high-performance and reliable cable internet connections (Form 4 S-IN).

General Regulations for Ordering Internet Connections

Offer

MCH Swiss Exhibition (Basel) Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "MCH") offers you, as an exhibitor, Internet connections at your exhibition stand. This enables you to use your Internet information in addition to your presence at the exhibition. The advantage of the MCH Internet connections is their high transmission speed and the unlimited internet access, irrespective of volume.

The following Services are Included in the Offer:

- Connection to the hall network (10 base T Ethernet)
- Connection cable for a terminal device with a type RJ45 plug access to the Internet via a 10 MB/s connection
- Unlimited access to the Internet without volume charges
- Possibility of connecting several appliances via a switch
- Technical hotline

The following Services are not included:

- Terminal device
- Additional hardware, such as a switch (this appliance can be rented from MCH by filling in the form "order for internet connection")
- Interface inside the stand
- Software (browser etc.)
- Configuration

Hall Network at Messe Basel

The hall network at MCH consists of a 10 base T Ethernet structure and is connected to the Internet via a 2 x 34 MB/s connection. The terminal devices need RJ45 connections.

Connection

The Internet connection is supplied to the stand via an Ethernet twisted pair cable (RJ45 jack, 10 Base T). Only one terminal device can be connected to this interface. The client is responsible for any networking inside the stand. For further terminal devices to be connected, a switch is necessary. These can be rented from MCH as part of this agreement.

Connection Restrictions

This connection is only valid for the stand quoted in this agreement. Connection to any other stand(s) without the authorisation of MCH is strictly prohibited.

Express Surcharge (Internet Connection)

Orders received on the first day of stand construction or later are subject to an additional charge of CHF 300.-.

Contravention/Liability

The exhibitor is liable for damage and disturbances that arise from the failure to observe the Exhibition's General Regulations, the general regulations pertaining to this form or the instructions given by Exhibition employees.
