

General Regulation for Ordering Event Technology

Transfer of the Hired Article

The exhibitor must confirm receipt and the return of the hired materials on the delivery note. The exhibitor must return the hired materials at the agreed time and place.

Defects/Damage/Liability

The principal/hirer/exhibitor is to provide notification without delay of defects that have been identified. MCH Swiss Exhibition (Basel) Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "MCH") shall endeavour to rectify the defects as quickly as possible. Repairs may only be carried out by specialists who have been authorised by MCH. Defects that may be identified shall not constitute an entitlement to withdraw from the contract/order, reduce the rental tariff or claim for damages. MCH refuses to accept any kind of liability for damage caused as a result of the operation of, or possible disruptions to, the rented property. The risk is transferred to the exhibitor upon the issue of the hired materials. The exhibitor is liable for any damage to or loss of the hired materials from the time of their issue to the time of their return.

The exhibitor shall be liable for damage or loss caused as a result of the non-observance of the provisions of the Exhibition Operating Regulations, the provisions set out in this form or the instructions issued by the Exhibition personnel.

Return of the Hired Article

The principal/hirer/exhibitor undertakes to return the rented property on the last day of the agreed rental period to the stand or the agreed place, to MCH, or to the authorised specialist. Dismantling the rented property is incumbent on MCH or the specialist authorised by MCH. Premature return of the rented property shall not entitle a party to reduce the agreed rental price.

Payment/Settlement

The service is paid for through the final invoice for the exhibition.
